How does it work?

Student Enrichment Club Leaders & Collaborative Team

Student Enrichment Club Leaders

Interested community members become club leaders

Determine the clubs that are offered

Decide schedule and parameters of club

Get volunteer clearance

Recruit other volunteers

Book space on campus as needed for meetings / events

Collaborative Team

Get the word out (like this fair)

Inform volunteers of requirements to get clearance

Manage sign ups

Collect fees needed for materials & expenses from participants

Help facilitate reserving rooms/facilities on campus

Manage reimbursements to club leaders

3rd Party Vendors & Collaborative Team

3rd Party Vendor

Provide staffing, insurance and materials

Go through clearance to offer clubs on PUSD grounds (if applicable)


Book space on campus as needed for meetings / events

Volunteer Status

Level 1

For volunteers who will work with students under the supervision of staff

Level 2

For volunteers who will work independently with students, without the supervision of a staff member

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How to Volunteer

Level 1

Steps:

- Fill out 3 forms (every year)
- Get a TB test (every 4 years)
- Submit forms and TB test to the Welcome Center

Timeline: 2 - 4 weeks

Requires renewal of forms each year

Level 2

Steps:

- Obtain Level 1
- Get a Level 2 form from Welcome Center
- Go to PUSD District Office during designated times & exchange form for application and Live Scan form
- Get Live Scan fingerprinting (FBI, DOJ)

Timeline: Several Weeks

Stays active as long as Level 1 forms are done every year.
